## INTRODUCTION: John 10:22-25

1. Gospel must lovingly, but plainly taught; too much at stake to do otherwise.
2. Yet, many religious leaders will not tell the Good news plainly, for fear of losing people.
3. The fact remains, some things need told plainly.

## IN THE NEWS... Lee Iococca Passes

Lido Anthony "Lee" Iacocca (October 15, 1924 – July 2, 2019) was an automobile executive in the U.S. famously known for the development of the Ford Mustang while at the *Ford Motor Company* in the 1960's, and then for salvaging the *Chrysler Corporation* as its CEO during the 1980's. He was the only executive to head operations of two of the Big Three automakers. He was approached on more than one occasion about running for the presidency of the United States which he repeatedly declined.

The thing that caught my attention during one news broadcast was the statement, "Lee Iococca, the man that saved Chrysler, has died". I don't recall which channel this was on, but my immediate thought was, "I wonder if the man who saved Chrysler, saved himself."

Perhaps this sounds cynical or even morbid to some, but it's a "hazard" of my calling. While some may wonder how much he was worth, and to whom did he leave his fortune, my first reaction is to think about the soul—that which abides forever.

I do not know Mr. Iococca's relationship with the Almighty and so, I do not sit here as I type, as his judge, but here is what I do know: *It is appointed unto man to die once* (Heb. 9:27). We know it's coming, so the wise, prudent one will *prepare to meet God* (Amos 4:12).

Sad indeed it would be if a man had the wisdom and influence to save a billion-dollar corporation, and yet went to the grave without heeding the words of Peter: *Save yourselves from this untoward generation* (Acts 2:40). I leave you with the very serious words of our Lord, Jesus Christ: *For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul* (Matt. 16:16)—*JK*
