ZECHARIAH'S VISION OF THE HIGH PRIEST Zech. 3:1-8

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Zechariah-"Remembered by Jehovah". Primary mission: to motivate the returned exiles to complete rebuilding the Jerusalem wall (Ezra 5:1-2; 6:14).
- 2. Zechariah's message was revealed to him in several visions with varying meanings.
- 3. Joshua the high priest, and by extension, Jerusalem, is representative of what happens when God's people fall away: They become unfit. They stand in need of deliverance.
- 4. Also, that renewal is possible *if* we submit to God and comply with His demands.

I. THE TRIBUNAL (1).

1.

- A. Joshua the high priest and (the) satan to his right stand before The Angel of the LORD (preincarnate Christ ?).
- B. "Satan", "adversary, accuser"; He accuses Joshua.
- C. Joshua stands for the priesthood; the priesthood represents the people.
 - Satan's accusations, therefore, are against Judah for their moral condition. a. Although back from captivity, yet defiled by idolatry, uncleanness.
 - a. Although back from captivity, yet defiled by idolatry, uncleanness.b. abandonment of God's house to build up their own, and the cursing of
 - God upon their labors (Hag. 1:6-11; 2:16-17)
 - c. Compare this with Ezekiel 22:26.
 - 2. Such accusations would prevent Jehovah from accepting the priests and likely were designed to oppose the rebuilding Jerusalem.

II. THE LORD'S REBUKE (2).

- A. The satan felt confident in his accusing the nation as they had a sinful past:
 - 1. Failed to distinguish between holy/common; clean/ unclean (Ezk. 22:26).
 - 2. Ignorance which led to other various sins (Hos. 4:6, 8).
 - 3. Teaching for pay (Mic. 3:11).
- B. The satan, however, underestimated the grace of Jehovah God.
 - 1. For the 3rd time in the book, Jehovah makes his selection of Jerusalem known (cf. 1:17; 2:12)—Jehovah will not be defeated!
 - 2. God asserts to the satan that these are his people by choice, not by merit.
- C. Joshua, the priests and the nation compared to "a brand plucked from the fire" (cf. Amos 4:11) —rescued!
 - 1. A "brand", or a "firebrand" (Not a branding iron).
 - 2. The fire (scholars differ): Egypt (Dt. 4:20); wilderness, Babylon?
 - 3. "Had the Lord in His mercy not interceded on behalf of Israel there would have been no nation at all" (Daugherty 278)!
 - a. God was their Savior (cf. Isa. 43:3).
 - b. Through Him a remnant would return (Isa. 10:21).
 - c. The remnant would receive a new heart and spirit (Ezk. 36:25-26f).

III. JOSHUA'S FILTHY GARMENTS (3).

- A. Symbolized the sinfulness of the people (Isa. 64:6).
- B. Joshua was bearing the sins of the priests and the nation.

IV. REMOVAL OF THE FILTHY GARMENTS (4).

- A. The priests had sinned, disqualified themselves as mediators. But God would forgive their "iniquity.
 - 1. Their forgiveness is pictured as changing filthy garments for clean.

- 2. This is a theme carried over to the NT (cf. Eph. 4:22-24; Col. 3:8-10).
- B. This gracious pronouncement of God symbolizes the removal of the guilt of sins of the nation—forgiveness pronounced!
- C. God has this ability and willingness; thus, Jehovah answers the satan's charges.

V. THE CLEAN TURBAN (5).

- A. Zechariah speaks up and demands a turban be put on Joshua's head.
 - 1. High priest's headpiece inscribed with "Holy to Jehovah" (Exo. 28:36-38).
 - 2. Characterized the former holiness of the priestly office and gave assurance that the priesthood would be fully restored.
- B. Once more, the high priest stood before Jehovah:
- C. The priestly nation had rendered themselves unfit to serve God and are now cleansed and made fit by the grace of God.

VI. JEHOVAH'S CHARGE (6-8).

- A. Assures Joshua that he will have access to Him on behalf of the people *if* they <u>are obedient</u> (6-7).
 - 1. With the great privileges, come great responsibilities.
 - 2. Joshua, the priests and the nation would have to walk in His ways (7).
 - 3. If they failed, the promise would be removed and the privilege of coming into the presence of God would be lost.
- B. Jehovah said that the priesthood will be a sign for, "I am bringing forth My Servant, the BRANCH" (8).
 - 1. The Branch in prophecy (Isa. 4:2; Isa. 11:1; Jer. 23:5; Jer. 33:15).
 - 2. This Branch would be a descendant of David, a servant of Jehovah and in Him the priesthood and Kingship of Zerubbabel (Hag. 2:23) would be made complete (Hailey 336). NONE OTHER THAN CHRIST!

VII. THE APPLICATION.

- A. The Cause of Being Unfit.
 - 1. Satan accuses and opposes us (1 Pet. 5:8).
 - 2. We lose our purity in sin even though God desires us to be pure (Jas. 1:27).
 - 3. As a burning stick being destroyed, God plucks us from the fire.
- B. The Cause of Deliverance.
 - 1. He takes our sin-stained garments from us and gives us new, clean, priestly garments (Isa. 1:18).
 - 2. We are given a crown (turban) that fades not away (1 Pet. 5:4).
- C. The Renewed Purpose.
 - 1. We then have a new walk (7).
 - a. Walk in the light (cf. 1 Jn. 1:7).
 - b. Must agree to walk with God (Amos (3:3).
 - 2. New Motives: to honor the Lord and be true to His calling (Phlp. 2:13).

CONCLUSION:

- 1. Sin separate us from God (Isa. 59:1-2). We must be renewed in our entire being to be one with God again.
- 2. The promised Branch has come in the person of Jesus Christ and He invites everyone to partake of the blessings of salvation that He offers—will obey Him today?
