SOCIALISM AND THE CHRISTIAN.

On the surface, Socialism sounds like a harmless and mutually advantageous way of life. Everybody has plenty and nobody goes without. In a perfect world it just might work, but we all know this is not a perfect world. Some even claim biblical principles for such an economic structure citing the early church's example from Acts 2: "And all that believed were together, and had all things common; And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all *men*, as every man had need" (44-45). Please note that these Christians *voluntarily* gave of their means and were neither compelled nor coerced by the state to do so. Godly benevolence comes from the heart, not the government!

Among the reasons Christians reject Socialism is that it is recognized as the transitional stage between Capitalism and Communism. Webster's College Dictionary, 4th Edition says under the third entry for "socialism": "the stage of society, **in Marxist doctrine**, coming between the capitalist stage, and the communist stage, in which private ownership of the means of production and distribution has been eliminated" (1360 emp. added). The late James D. Bales in his book, "Communism: Its Faith and Fallacies" points out the fact that socialism is a bridge to Communism as well (81-82).

Brethren and friends, anything that leads to ungodliness is itself ungodly! Communism is rooted in the hypothesis of evolution which, as you are very well aware, is an ungodly, anti-biblical doctrine. This sort of thinking was behind the National Socialist movement which emerged in the 1930's in Germany and became known as the Nazi Party. We know where that led!

Another reason Christians reject socialism is that it is simply antagonistic to religion in general and Christianity in particular especially where God's design for the family is concerned. Mark Levin noted that, "Marx believed that the nuclear family was a manifestation of bourgeois society. Like religion, the nuclear family interfered with the kind of social ideological brainwashing necessary to achieve the Marxist paradise" (American Marxism 120).

How do we prevent such from taking over? We must pray that God will have mercy on us. We must teach our kids the truth about creation and evolution and indoctrinate them in the Bible! We must make our voices heard at the polls and not elect socialist-minded candidates. It is up to us to see that the bridge of socialism is never completed. We as the church of Christ must remember that we are the church of Christ and that we will not tolerate the ungodly, sinful, socialist agenda which is designed to draw us away from our Creator!—0%.

- D. They were told to repent **and** (+) be baptized **for** (=) remission of sins.

- B. His Encounter With Christ (Acts 9:1-9).

 - 1. Believe on the Lord Jesus (31). But who was Jesus? The Gentile/Philippian didn't know.
 - 2. So, they spake unto him the word of the Lord (32) per Romans 10:17.
