THE GOSPEL IN FIVE SECONDS

1 Cor. 15:1-4

INTRODUCTION:

1. We all need a second chance at one time or another.
2. God has graciously given man the opportunity of a second chance where we need it most—our eternal salvation.

I. THE GOSPEL IS CONTAINED IN A SECOND LAW.

- A. The First Law/Covenant
 1. Given to Israel at Sinai (Exo. 20f; Heb. 8:8f; Eph. 2:15; 2 Pet. 1:3) for Israel so they might receive the promise God made to Abraham in Gen 12.
 2. Never intended to be permanent (Gal. 3:19).
 3. Did not remove sins (Heb. 10:4).
 4. Taken away at Calvary (Col. 2:14).
- B. The Second Law/ Covenant.
 1. The 2nd Law did what the 1st could not (Heb. 8:7).
 2. Under 1st, sins remembered each year (Heb. 10:3; Heb. 8:13).
 3. Christ is the mediator of the new testament (Heb. 9:15), by virtue of His own blood (Mt. 26:28)

II. THE GOSPEL COMMANDS A SECOND BIRTH.

- A. Second Birth Commanded (John 3:1-7).
- B. Second Birth Expounded (1 Pet. 1:3).
- C. Second Birth Expected (1 Pet. 1:23).

III. THE GOSPEL PROMISES A SECOND COMING.

- A. Jesus Promised to Reappear (Jn. 14:1-3).
- B. The Angels Promised (Acts 1:9-11).
- C. James urged us to “be patient ...unto the coming of the Lord” (5:7).
- D. Paul said he would come with His angels (2 Thes. 1:7-9).
- E. When He appears, He will judge the world in righteousness (Acts 17:31).

IV. THE GOSPEL WARNS OF A SECOND DEATH.

- A. All will experience one death/ separation (Heb. 9:27; 1 Sam. 20:3; Psalms 90:10).
- B. The lost will experience the second death— (Rev. 21:7-8).

V. THE GOSPEL CONTAINS A SECOND PARDON.

- A. Initial Pardon: We are forgiven (pardoned) of all sins initially (first) at baptism, cf. Acts 2:38; 22:16.
- B. Second Pardon (1 Jn. 1:9; Acts 8:22).
 1. This second pardon does not mean we may sin with impunity!
 2. To do such would be to tempt God (Mt. 4:7; Dt. 6:16).
 3. No allowance for blatant rebellion and apostasy (Heb. 10:26).

CONCLUSION: Will you make Jesus the Lord of your life this very second?

SOME “DOS” AND “DON’TS” OF BIBLE STUDY

Donnie Barnes (1946-2013)

- DO remember that the Bible is God’s Word
 - DO approach the Bible with reverence and respect
 - DO pray for wisdom and understanding in your study
 - DO study rather than just read or browse through the Bible
 - DO study the Bible regularly
 - DO study the Bible all the way through
 - DO set aside a place and regular time conducive for Bible Study
 - DO make notes and markings in your Bible
 - DO use a reliable translation of the Bible
 - DO use useful aids (concordance, commentary, dictionary, etc.) in your study
 - DO remember that each verse has only one correct interpretation
 - DO remember that a correct interpretation may have several applications
-
- DON’T approach the Bible irrelevantly
 - DON’T force an interpretation that isn’t present in the text
 - DON’T interpret one verse so as to contradict another plain passage
 - DON’T twist the Scriptures so as to support a preconceived idea
 - DON’T ignore the fact that there are some difficult passages in the Bible
 - DON’T take a text out of context
 - DON’T use translations that are unreliable
 - DON’T fail to study all other passages on the subject you are studying
 - DON’T hesitate to use good Bible study helps
 - DON’T forget to ask God to help you understand what you are studying
 - DON’T take what people say over what the Bible says
 - DON’T ever give up studying the Word of God
