BEWARE OF THE WOLVES

INTRODUCTION: Matthew 7:15-20

- 1. Many think all religious leaders may be trusted.
- 2. Jesus warned His disciples of "false prophets" (Mt. 7:15-20).
- 3. Are you concerned about false prophets today? You should; they're everywhere! How do I know this? Look at the diversity in religious world.
- 4. We need reminded of the danger; and know how to spot "wolves" entering in.

THERE WILL BE FALSE PROPHETS.

A. Warnings From Paul

T.

- 1. To Ephesian elders (Acts 20:28-31).
- 2. To church at Corinth (2 Cor. 11:13-15).
- 3. To Timothy (1 Tim. 4:1-3; 2 Tim. 3:1-9).
- B. Warnings From Others.
 - 1. Peter told of their rise (2 Pet. 2:1-3).
 - 2. John called for their testing (1 Jn. 4:1).
 - 3. Jude told of their presence (3-4).

II. WE CAN IDENTIFY FALSE PROPHETS.

- A. By Investigating the Fruit of Their Life.
 - 1. "By their fruits ye shall know them" (Mt. 7:16-20).
 - 2. The heart eventually reveals its true intentions (Pro. 23:7; Mt. 15:19).
 - 3. False teachers oft betrayed by:
 - a. Greediness (lavish lifestyles, etc. charging admission to their "show")
 - b. Immorality (adultery, and/or fornication)
 - c. Lust for power (religious empires)
- B. By Investigating the Fruit of their Teaching.
 - 1. Note their methods:
 - a. Work secretly (2 Pet. 2:1; 2 Cor. 8:21).
 - b. Appeal to covetousness (2 Pet. 2:3).
 - c. They use deceptive words and tactics (2 Tim. 3:13; cf. 2 Pet. 2:3).
 - 1) Twisting Scripture to advance their own agenda cf. Mt. 4:6.
 - 2) Genuine teachers handle God's word correctly (2 Tim. 2:14-16).
 - 2. Note their doctrine.
 - a. Note how they twist/pervert Scrip (Gal. 1:8-9).
 - b. Note how they teach things contrary to Scripture (Dt. 13:1-4).
 - c. Note how their teaching compares to God's word (1 Jn. 4: 1, 6).

CONCLUSION:

- 1. Judging the heart of any teaching is not necessary; we only need to observe the fruit they bear . . . the heart will reveal itself.
- 2. We must know God's word so that:
 - A. We know what to look for in the life of a teacher.
 - B. We know what to listen for in the doctrine of a teacher.
- 3. God said through Hosea, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge" (Hos. 4:6).

FOUR THINGS EVERYBODY SHOULD KNOW.

John 3:16 is one of the most beautiful passages in the bible. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life". Sadly, it is also one most misused and least understood. Man says, "All we have to do to go to Heaven is just believe in Jesus Christ." If that is all that was required, John 3:16 is the only verse we would need. The bible is a book of hope and assurance. It tells us the history of the world; man's fall and God's plan to redeem him. BUT there are some sobering facts we must come to accept.

NOT EVERYONE WILL BE SAVED. Jesus said, *Not everyone that saith unto me Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven*" (Matt. 7:21). There it is! Not only are sinners not going to be saved, but even some religious folk. False teachers are clearly religious persons, crying, "Lord, Lord." Their failure is not that of inactivity but indulgence in the wrong activity. They not only deceive but are themselves deceived. Their gross error is in doing their own will instead of Christ's.

MORE WILL BE LOST THAN SAVED. Matthew records the words of Jesus saying, "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it (7:13-14). The comparative number of the saved to the lost is plain from this. The relative number of redeemed souls in any generation is not the scale by which God's success may be measured. God will keep on saving men until the "fullness" of his purpose is achieved (Rom. 11:25).

MANY WHO BELIEVE THEY ARE SAVED WILL BE LOST. Some will be pronounced "lost" and may object saying, "Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (Matt. 7:22-23). The proverbs writer reminds us that, "There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death (14:12).

NO SALVATION CAN BE FOUND AFTER DEATH. If our righteous judge proclaims that He never knew us, it is because we never made the effort to know Him (Matt. 7:23). Once we pass from this life, hope is gone: "And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence" (Luke 16:26). The time of our passing and the day of the Lord are nearing with each tick of the clock and depending upon your soul's condition that is either good news, or it is terrifying.
