CHURCH OF CHRIST AT SMYRNA

INTRODUCTION: Revelation 2:8-11

- 1. Shortest of the 7 letters
- 2. Nothing known about the establishment of the congregation.
- 3. Located in Asia Minor (modern Turkey)
 - A. 1st Smyrna est. circa 1K B.C. on a mountainside
 - 1) Thought to be impregnable; not so, fell 600 B.C.
 - 2) Rebuilt by Alexander the Great who moved its location nearly 2 mi. to the coast of the Aegean Sea.
 - B. A large seaport
 - C. Population mostly anti-Christian Jews—Polycarp martyred here
 - D. "Crown city" or "first city" known for beauty, literature, aqueducts, Roman culture, and loyalty
 - E. Boasted many temples
 - 1) Dionysus, god of fruitfulness and wine
 - 2) Roma, Roman goddess (195 B.C.)
 - 3) Emperor Tiberius 23 B.C.

DISCUSSION:

I. THE COUNSELOR (8).

- A. Christ's Salutation (8a): to the messenger, representative, eldership.
- B. Christ's Description (8b).
 - 1. The First and the Last (see; 1:11, 17, 2:19; 22:13).
 - a. Smyrna thought they were first
 - b. Whatever greatness Smyrna had achieved, Christ was greater!
 - c. Alpha and Omega (see; 1:8, 11; 21:6; 22:13).
 - 2. Formerly Dead, Now Living
 - a. See; <u>1:17-18</u>
 - b. This church needed reassured that though Christ had been killed, He was alive for evermore.
 - c. They were suffering and would suffer—needed this encouragement—Christ has their back; even if martyred, He has authority over death.
 - d. We have a resurrected, living Savior; not a dead, dumb idol like heathen priests who hold mock resurrections for their handmade images.

II. THE COMMENDATION (9).

- A. Christ Knew Their Works.
 - 1. Christ omniscient- (Jn. 2:24; 21:17).
 - 2. The church was not dead; they put forth significant effort.

- B. Christ Knew Their Tribulation
 - 1. "Tribulation"-to suffer severely w/ great hardship, crushing, grinding.
 - 2. Contextually, if not by the Romans, then from the Jews
- C. Christ Knew Their Poverty.
 - 1. Possible their poverty due to confiscation of property by the persecutors.
 - 2. Although poor materially, rich spiritually (works and longsuffering).
- D. Christ Knew the Blasphemy Against Them.
 - 1. Blasphemy means evil speaking designed to be injurious
 - 2. Spoke evil of Jesus, no doubt, and His followers, "the hanged one" (cf. Gal. 3:13; 1 Cor. 1:23).
 - 3. Those who claimed to be real Jews but were not (Rom. 2:28-29).

III. THE COUNSEL (10).

- A. Be Fearless
 - 1. There would be more tribulation to face; Jews and Nero would not let up
 - 2. "The devil" (Nero Caesar?) would imprison many Christians in an effort to get them to recant their faith in Christ (cf. Mt. 24:9-13).
 - 3. Tribulation 10 days: a brief time compared to the eternal crown of life
 - a. In NT, "crown of life" a metaphor=eternal life
 - b. "Crown" (1 Cor. 9:25; 2 Tim. 4:8; Jas. 1:12).
 - c. Jesus told them to expect greater persecution in the future
- B. Be Faithful! —Keep on being faithful even as you approach death!
 - 1. This is exactly how Christ faced His crucifixion
 - 2. He appeared to lose the battle, however, CHRIST WON!
 - a. The grave could not keep Him (Psa. 16:10; Acts 2:27),
 - b. Neither will it keep us (2 Tim. 2:11; Jn. 5:28-29).

IV. THE CHALLENGE (11).

- A. He Who Hears: Everyone with the faculty of hearing/understanding must heed what Christ is saying—give the strictest attention.
- B. He Who Overcomes
 - 1. This is our personal responsibility:
 - a. Q: How can we be victorious conquerors if we are martyred?
 - b. A: (Rom. 8:35-37).
 - 2. By remaining faithful to Christ, we subdue all of enemies, therefore we shall not be touched by the second death, which is eternal damnation (Rev. 20:6, 14; 21:8).
