THE CHURCH AT EPHESUS

INTRODUCTION: Revelation 2:1-7

- 1. Three internal sources of info: Acts 18:19-21; 19; 20:18-38; Eph. 1-6; Rev. 2:1-7
- 2. Birth Of The Church In Ephesus (Acts 18-20).

I. THE COMMISSION (2:1a).

- A. To the Angel . . .
- B. Speculations abound re: ID of theses "angels"/ "messengers".

II. THE CHARACTER (2:1b).

- A. Identifies source of message.
- B. Description based upon vision of ch. 1. Reveals 2 facts about Jesus they needed to know:
 - 1. His power & protection
 - 2. His presence & perception

III. COMMENDATION (2:2-3, 6).

- A. Jesus Knows Them (knows this church too).
- B. Jesus Knows Their Works (Eph. 1:15-16).
 - 1. Endured Paul's boldness in preaching/teaching for 3 mo. (Act 19:8).
 - 2. Were patient; would not tolerate persistent evildoers and liars (2, 6).
 - 3. Did not grow weary in well-doing (3; cf. 2 Th. 3:13).
- C. Jesus Knows Their Disdain for the Deeds of the Nicolaitans (6).

IV. CONDEMNATION (2:4).

- A. "First love" means "the love you had at the first."—Now apathetic
- B. Had an appearance of godliness but had drifted from real love (cf. 1 Cor. 13:1-3).

V. THE CORRECTION (2:5).

- A. Be Remembering
 - 1. When they were lost (**Eph. 2:1, 3, 12**).
 - 2. What Christ has done (Eph. 2:13)
 - 3. Their initial zeal—the excitement and thrill of those days
- B. Be Repentant—return to that first love; not apathetic —OR—
- C. Be Removed—lose ID as a church of Christ

VI. THE CALL (2:7a): hear! Listen! This is important!

- A. A fave saying of Jesus (Mt. 11:15; 13:9, 43 et al).
- B. Each of you must make personal application.

VII. THE CHALLENGE (2:7b).

- A. Jesus had warned them- unless something changed, spiritual death awaited them.
- B. If they responded to the challenge to hear—and *overcome* =spiritual life.
 - 1. Man lost the right to the Tree of Life in the garden (Gen. 3:24).
 - 2. The final ch. Of The Revelation pictures the Tree of Life flourishing in the Paradise of God— (Rev. 22:1-2).
 - 3. This is the Heavenly Eden, the realm of man's restored state in the presence of God.

THE SUFFERING SERVANT

From time to time I like to sit and read Isaiah 53 as a reminder of what the Man, Jesus, endured for my sins and the sins of the world—past, present, and, God-willing, future. I think sometimes we forget that Jesus took on flesh and blood, and therefore was not impervious to pain. Jesus also had feelings: He loved, He became angry at times, How did He feel about being betrayed?

Reading this prophetic passage of Scripture reminds me that Jesus knew His sojourn upon the earth was not going to be easy nor filled with the satisfaction of personal hopes where all of His desires were met. But His focus was not on Himself, but us. He had a job to do, and He did it masterfully. Read the words of the inspired prophet, Isaiah, and remember as you read that Jesus endured all of this for you—7%.

Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, *There is* no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken. And they made His grave with the wicked—But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth.

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. He shall see the labor of His soul, *and* be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities. Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors (Isaiah 53:1-12).
