THE CHURCH OF CHRIST AT SARDIS

INTRODUCTION: Revelation 3:1-6

- 1. Origin of city unknown
- 2. Obadiah may refer to Sardis in vs. 20 calling the city, "Shepharad"
- 3. Grk mythology prevailed; many legends RE: King Midas, Croesus—magnificent temple dedicated to Artemis (Diana), also main deity of Ephesus.
- 4. Wealthy, known for decadence, political corruption, luxury, apathy, and immorality.
- 5. Establishment of church unknown—perhaps when Paul was in Ephesus for 3 yrs.

DISCUSSION:

I. THE COUNSELOR (3:1a).

- A. The Angel of the Church—the representative messenger (aggelos), eldership (?).
- B. Jesus Identifies Himself as:
 - 1. He that hath the Seven Spirits—7=perfection, the perfect Holy Spirit (1:4).
 - 2. He that hath the 7 stars—the messenger/angel of each church
 - 3. As such, Jesus held the destiny of the church in His hand (1:20).

II. THE CHASTENING (3:1b—2).

- A. "I know thy works" (1b).
 - 1. "Know", full, complete knowledge, fullest extent. Christ omniscient (Jn. 2:24; 21:17).
 - 2. "Works" labor, to exert one's power, be active
- B. Have a reputation of being alive, but really are dead (1c).
 - 1. Sardis not as glorious as it had been, yet reveled in its former glory, thus was Arrogant &self-sufficient.
 - 2. Enjoyed a glowing, vibrant reputation of a hard-working church (1 Sam. 16:7).
 - 3. By whom was such a reputation held?
 - 4. Seemingly satisfied with her own apathetic and self-congratulatory condition; **EX**: Pharisee Luke 18:9-14.
- C. Though their deeds are far from being right in God's sight, evidently, a spark of life remained (2).
 - 1. "Be watching"—vigilant, as a soldier on guard duty.
 - 2. Their works were not perfect, "fulfilled" (Mt. 5:17)
 - 3. Jesus says, "No! Don't quit! Get up and finish what you've started!" Good starters/lousy finishers (cf. Gal. 5:7).

III. THE COUNSEL (3:3).

- A. Remember—be mindful of, fix the thoughts upon
 - 1. Receiving/hearing the Gospel of Christ / salvation
 - 2. The design of which was to help them rekindle their former zeal in Christ
- B. Retain— "hold fast" (Heb. 10:23; Rev. 2:4-5).

C. Repent

- The instant we recognize spiritual problems, repentance is the priority, the next logical step—change.
- 2. Repent of actions undone which caused this church to be on life-support.
- 3. If we can get one to truly repent, won't have to convince them to be baptized; they'll know its necessary **EX**: Acts 17:30; 2 Pet. 3:9.

D. Regret.

- If repentance does not follow, Christ will come upon them as a thief very ominous—nothing good would happen at Christ's punitive appearing.
- 2. "If not watchful". Being watchful not just about eyes opened, also being active in Lord's service.

IV. THE COMMENDATION (3:4).

- A. Had not defiled garment—taken no part in Pagan worship/worldliness/or otherwise engaged in habitual sin.
- B. Those wishing to live in purity/righteousness have been given everything necessary to do so—1 Cor. 10:13; 2 Pet. 1:3; 2 Tim. 3:16-17.
- C. "In white". Purity, victory
- D. These ones are "worthy". Suitable, qualified.
 - 1. Not worthiness by our own merit, but imputed/accounted (Rom. 4:20-25).
 - 2. We stand *as though* we are worthy being redeemed by the blood of Christ (Eph. 1:7; cf. Col. 1:14).

V. THE CHALLENGE (3:5-6).

- A. Their Bodies Attired in White (3:5a). defiled garment replaced w/ white (purity, victory) back in fellowship (redeemed to) w/ Christ.
- B. Their Names Announced in Heaven (3:5b—6).
 - 1. Not blot out his name (5b). by apathy, in peril of having name removed from the "Book of Life" (Exo. 32:32-34; cf. Psa. 69:28; Mal. 3:16; Heb. 12:23; Lk. 10:20; Phlp. 4:3; Rev. 20:12).
 - 2. God can and has changed His mind—Hezekiah (Isa. 38:5).
 - 3. If God would never change His mind, should we still be a praying people?
 - 4. Christ will *confess*—publicly declare—us to God (Mt. 10:32; cf. (Rom. 10:9-10; 12:1-2; 1 Jn. 1:7).

C. He Who Hears.

- 1. Everyone with the faculty of hearing/understanding must heed Christ's word—give the strictest attention
- 2. Must make personal application which implies personal responsibility.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. Cannot simply go through the motions—the right actions from the right motive.
- 2. We started well; we must go on unto perfection (Heb. 6:1). We do this by:
 - A. Being watchful—paying attention
 - B. Remembering why we started and Who enabled us—Christ
 - C. Holding on the faith insistently and repenting when we falter.
 - D. And by keeping ourselves unspotted from the world (Jas. 1:27).
