FOUR REQUIREMENTS OF FORGIVENESS Eph. 4:30-32

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Forgiveness is often misunderstood or taken lightly.
- 2. Some congregations, and individual Christians with problems, likely do not have a forgiving spirit.
- 3. Forgiveness requires at least four things; we must . . .

DISCUSSION:

I. KNOW WHAT IT MEANS TO FORGIVE.

- A. Forgiveness Defined:
 - 1. "to send away from, let be, let alone, cancel a debt". When we forgive, we treat that one like we did before.
 - 2. "To forgive is to accept within yourself the consequences of the sins of others. It means to accept the pain, the problems and the burden that comes when someone sins against you. Forgiveness is neither an easy nor a frequent gift".
- B. OT views of God's forgiveness (Mic. 7:19; Ps. 103:8-12).
- C. Forgiveness Described (Heb. 8:12), he behaves as if He forgets.

II. KNOW WHY WE ARE TO FORGIVE.

- A. A Command from God.
- B. An Attitude (Col. 3:13).
- C. A Reciprocity (Mk. 11:25,26). (forgive to be forgiven).

III. KNOW WHEN TO FORGIVE.

- A. Forgive When? (Lk. 17:3). Forgive when it happens.
- B. Forgive How Often (Mt. 18:21-22).
 - 1. Peter willing to go extra mile and forgive 7 Xs (OT required only three Xs c.f. Amos 1:4) This fell short of Christ's expectations of 70 X 7 (or, limitless).
 - 2. Christians to be in the "forgiveness business".

- B. Examples of great men
 - 1. Jacob & Esau (Gen. 33:4-5).
 - 2. David & Saul in the cave (1 Sam. 24:1-7).

 - 4. Our Lord on the cross (Lk. 23:34).
