## WHAT MOTHERS DESERVE John 19:25-27

### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. In 1907, Anna Jarvis of Philadelphia started the campaign to honor mothers, two years after her own mother died.
- 2. What do our mothers deserve from a biblical perspective?

#### I. MOTHER OF JESUS.

- A. Obedient to God's Law of Chastity (Mt. 1:18-23; Isa. 7:14).
- B. Obedient to Civil Law (Lk. 2:1-7).
- C. Obedient to God's Law—Law of Moses
  - 1. RE: circumcision (Lk. 2:21; cf. Lev. 12:3).
  - 2. RE: purification (Lk. 2:22-24; cf. Lev. 12:2-8).
  - 3. RE: Passover at Jerusalem (Lk. 2:41-50; cf. Dt. 16:1, 16).
- D. Continual Devotion to Her Son (Jn. 19:25-27).
  - 1. Mary was present at many recorded key events in Jesus' life.
  - 2. She had conducted herself in such a way that Jesus was concerned about her welfare.

#### II. WHAT DO OUR MOTHERS DESERVE FROM US?

- A. Our Mothers Deserve Our Care
  - 1. Parents, especially widowed mothers, deserve our utmost care.
    - a. One of Jesus' final concerns; His mother's care (Jn. 19:25-28).
    - b. Paul's clear instructions: 1 Tim. 5:4,8,16; cf. Jas. 1:27.
  - 2. Indeed, children are to be their parents' "social security."
- B. Our Mothers Deserve Our Honor
  - 1. Command With Promise (Exo. 20:12; Eph. 6:2; Jos. 23:14-16).
  - 2. Consequences For Compromise (Pro. 20:20).
    - a. "Cursing" a parent = wishing for evil to happen to them.
    - b. The child's lamp being put out=a curse upon the child.
    - c. In contrast, the child who honors parents prolongs his days and improves life (Dt. 5:16).
- C. Our Mothers Deserve Our Obedience.
  - 1. How Do We Honor? (Eph. 6:1; Col. 3:20; Pro. 1:8).
  - 2. Even Jesus obeyed His mother as He was growing (Lk 2:51).

# **CONCLUSION:**

- 1. Mother of Jesus feared the Lord with Godly fear- obedient to civil law and God's law—notable example for her Son.
- 2. That Jesus care for her in His final moments gives us insight to how we should regard our mothers.
- 3. Most importantly, she enabled Him to grow spiritually (Lk. 2:52).
