IF IN THIS LIFE ONLY

INTRODUCTION: 1 Cor. 15:16-22

- 1. One of mankind's major barriers to faith is his attachment to this world.
- 2. We will exist in consciousness for eternity in one of two places and if we enter eternity with the idea that this life is all there is, we will be of all men most miserable.

IV. IF IN THIS LIFE ONLY, WE HAVE HOPE OF HAVING EVERYTHING WE WANT—WEALTH AND PROSPERITY.

V. IF IN THIS LIFE ONLY WE HAVE HOPE THAT SIN DID NOT EXIST.

- A. Temptation is everywhere (1 Pet. 5:8) "Adversary."

 - 1. Christ (Mt. 4:1f).
 - 2. Xtians (1 Pet. 4:12).

CONCLUSION:

- 1. There is more to our existence than the joys and heartaches of this life. Here, we have a mixture; in the next life it will be all joy, or all sorrow.
- 2. If your only preparation is for this life, you will be of all people most miserable for eternity. You can do something about it now!

HEAVEN IS NOT A PLACE ON EARTH.

Despite the seeming popularity of the pop song, *Heaven Is A Place On Earth*, the sentiments contained therein could not be further from the truth. Even though Bible believing folks know, by faith, that Heaven is real, not everyone believes it and many do not care. Perhaps this is because if they admit that Heaven is real they might feel compelled to believe Hell is just as real—and it is—and this makes them uncomfortable.

To combat this notion of Heaven and Hell, perhaps in an attempt to evade any sense of accountability, many have opted to dismiss anything regarding an afterlife. They would rather believe in *nothing* than *something*, and when it dawned on somebody that *nothing* is a depressing thing to look forward to, they began defining Heaven by their own terms, and trying to bring the attributes of Heaven to earth—how ironic!

In Scripture, the adjective "heavenly" is used to distinguish between the things of earth and the things of Heaven. For example, Jesus said, "If I have told you *earthly* things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you *of heavenly* things" (John 3:12)? Or when the Hebrews writer said, "But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the <u>heavenly</u> Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels" (Heb. 12:22).

However, today it is not uncommon to hear this beautiful word used to describe things that are wholly earthly, and even mundane. "How was dessert?" "Oh, absolutely heavenly!" If this does not violate Jesus' command to "Swear not at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne (Matt. 5:34), it's dangerously close! But my point is that many of the very ones who dismiss Heaven want Heaven on earth, and it just cannot be.

I wish there were no injustice on earth, no war, crime, racism, class-warfare, animal cruelty, and I appreciate the advocates for justice and right in these. To desire these things on earth is admirable, but to expect them is not reasonable and is a hopeless endeavor.

The *Heaven-on-earthers* have one thing right; Heaven is to be preferred because, "[i]t will be inhabited by the Holy Godhead (Revelation 4:8), holy angels (Luke 9:26), and the "just" (i.e., justified) ones who have been made perfect (Hebrews 12:23)", but it will not be on earth for it "shall be burned up" (2 Pet. 3:10).—7%.
