### THE WORDS OF JESUS

### INTRODUCTION: John 6:63-68

- 1. Words were Christ's method of communicating with man; His disciples and Holy Apostles.
- 2. These words have been preserved for us in the post-miraculous age today in the Bible. The words of Jesus . . .

## I. ARE SPIRIT & LIFE (63).

- A. The spirit within man is that which animates the man thus giving him physical life.
  - 1. Breath of life
    - a. Creation (Gen. 2:7).
    - b. Noah's flood (Gen. 6:17).
    - c. Death—"gave up the ghost": Isaac (Gen. 35:29); Jesus (Mk. 15:37), Ananias (Acts 5:5).
  - 2. Flesh w/o spirit is useless—a dead body.
- B. The Holy Spirit within man is source of spiritual life.
  - 1. Is fair to say that God breathed to us the Holy Spirit for our spiritual life.
  - 2. Even if our physical body has the spirit of animation (phys life), w/o the Holy Spirit of Christ—His imparted word—we are spiritually dead.

## II. ARE TO BE BELIEVED (64).

- A. God created man w/ liberty to make his own choices, and with each choice we make comes a natural consequence.
  - 1. We may choose to obey Christ and reap the promised blessings eternal life (Mt. 25:46b).
  - 2. We may choose to reject Christ and reap the promised condemnation—eternal death (Mt. 25:46a).
- B. To believe Jesus' is to believe His words and to trust Him.

## III. ARE EXCLUSIVE (65).

- A. Not denominational predestination, which negates man's freewill.
  - 1. By itself, this verse could be confusing, that's why we must examine everything the Bible says about any subject.
  - 2. Note the "whosoever" passages: John 3:16; Lk. 6:47; Acts 2:21; Rev. 22:17.
- B. God Draws All Men the Same Way (6:44-45).
  - 1. No latter-day revelations
  - 2. No "lottery", or "salvation sweepstakes"

#### IV. CAN BE REJECTED (66-67).

- A. Christ does not force us to accept His word.
- B. Christ does not force us to abide in His word if we do accept it (<u>2 Pet.</u> <u>2:20-22</u>).

#### V. ARE PARTICULAR TO DEITY (68).

- A. Many people through the ages have made astounding promises on which they could not deliver. Christ is no ordinary man!
- B. Peter recognized the exclusive nature of Christ's words.
  - 1. Christ IS the Word (Jn. 1:1-3).
  - 2. "No man ever spoke like this Man" (Jn. 7:46)!
  - 3. No man could offer salvation of sins apart from Jesus Christ

#### CONCLUSION:

- 1. Our text highlights some of the stark realities of the words of Christ.
- 2. This text should make the sincere student of God's word keenly aware of the gravity and blessings of His words.

#### DO NOT GIVE THEM YOUR APPROVAL

When the apostle Paul was under arrest for the cause of Christ, he became dissatisfied with the direction the proceedings were headed. As a Roman citizen (Acts 22:25-28) he had the privilege of taking his case to the highest court in the Roman empire; and that he did. "For if I am an offender, or have committed anything deserving of death, I do not object to dying; but if there is nothing in these things of which these men accuse me, no one can deliver me to them. I appeal to Caesar" (Acts 25:11).

When you and I become dissatisfied with the way things are we have the opportunity to "appeal to Caesar", our elected officials. The men who founded our great nation gave the populace the recourse of the vote. While the system we have is not perfect, it's what we have. And Christians must use the power of the vote to the best of their abilities to advocate for the cause of Christ. We cannot be apathetic like the Gentiles in Paul's day whereof he wrote, "*Though they know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them*" (Rom. 1:32 ESV).

We have an opportunity this week to guard against an atrocious wrong that is being perpetrated upon the unborn—the truly innocent among us. I urge you to use your God-given power of the vote to take a stand for Christ and His divine morality—JK.
