WWJD

While waiting in line at a Christian bookstore, a man was overheard asking a clerk about a display of hats with the letters WWJD on them. The clerk explained that WWJD stood for "What Would Jesus Do?" The idea was to get people to consider that question before making any decision. The man pondered for a moment and then replied, "I don't think He'd pay \$29.99 for that hat!" Every time I think about that I chuckle. He was right. I doubt Jesus would pay that for a cap either, but I still like the message.

Jesus left us an example (1 Peter 2:21). He expects us to follow His lead. That's what disciples do. The apostle Paul pleaded with Christians, "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ" (1 Corinthians 11:1 ESV). In fact, he went so far as to say: "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is not longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me" (Galatians 2:19, 20 NASB). He really tried to live his life as Christ had lived His. He tried to do what Jesus would do!

It's not profound, but it is profoundly helpful. And it's not as difficult as one might think. It's not that hard to know what Jesus would do, but it's often hard for us to do it! What would Jesus do? Would He buy that lottery ticket? Would He run that stop sign? Would He use that kind of language? Would He smoke that cigarette? Would He tell that story? Would He drink that beverage? Would He read that book? Would He subscribe to that magazine? Would He wear those clothes? Would He stop to help? Would He go the extra mile? Would He understand? Would He care? Would He forgive?

As I said, the answers are obvious, but are we willing to do what Jesus would do? It's a question worth considering, and the answer has eternal significance.
