In Acts 4:12 it says, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." The Apostles were brought in and questioned about the man who they had healed. They boldly proclaimed Jesus Christ before the Sanhedrin, declaring that he is the chief cornerstone.
