Digging Deeper

Saint

Greek term meaning “separated”; a “saint” refers to an ordinary member of Christ’s church who has submitted to gospel obedience (Phil. 1:1; 4:21; 2 Thes. 1:10)

A saint (hagios) is one who has gone through the process of sanctification (hagiasmos).

It thus denotes one who has been “separated” from the world, and who enjoys a special relationship with Christ. The process involved in becoming a saint includes: believing in the Lord (Mark 16:16), repenting of sin (Acts 2:38), and consummating these acts of obedience by the “washing of water” (Eph 5:25, 1 Cor.6:11)-Baptism.
