Sin has affected man in the following way:

Physically

Disease and death were introduced into this world as a consequence of evil (Fen. 2:17; Rom. 5:12)

Geophysically

Many of the erratic features of the earth's surface, which allow for storms, earthquakes, etc. are the result of the great flood of Noah's day – which came as the effect of sin. (Gen 6: 5-ff)

Culturally

The communication problem that mankind has, due to great variety of human cultures and languages, is traceable to ambitious rebellion on the part of our ancestors (cf. Gen. 11: 1-9)

Psychologically

Man is generally without the peace of mind for which his heart longs (look at the number of psychiatrists listed in the yellow pages!). “They have made them crooked paths whosever goeth therein doth not know peace” (Isa. 59:8; cf 57:21).

Spiritually

By sin, man has created a chasm between himself and God. “Your iniquities have separated you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, so that he will not hear” (Isa 59:2). The ultimate “wages” of sinfulness is death, i.e. separation from God forever (Rom. 6:23).
