A careful study of the Scriptures makes one thing absolutely clear: the Creator's efforts on behalf of sinful man are the result of **pure love**. Here are some facts that need to be carefully considered:

Jehovah's love for mankind was strictly **undeserved**.

Salvation is offered to us even though we are ungodly, sinners, and enemies (note the use of those three terms in Rom. 5:6-10). "Herein is love not that we loved God, but that he loved us" (1Jn. 4:10).

The love of God is **universal**, thus, not discriminatory (cf. Jn. 3:15, 16). He would have all men to be saved (1 Tim. 2:4) – if they would be saved (Jn. 5:40), for he is not willing that any should perish (2 Pet. 3:9).

The Lords's love was **not merely theoretical**, rather, it was practical and sacrificial. Love gives, and so God gave his Son for the sin of the world. Moreover, the Son, with identical love, gave himself as well (Gal. 1:4).

The love of deity is **unquenchable**. Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. Read Rom. 8:35 ff and be thrilled by it. Only Man's wanton rejection of that love can put him beyond the practical appropriation of the same!
