Give diligence to present thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed handling aright the word of truth (2Tim 2:15).

The expression "handling aright" (ASV) translates the Greek word orthotomeo, from orthos (Straight) and temno (to cut): hence, to cut straight. Within this context the term simply means to teach accurately, soundly. The emphasis is the exact opposite of that disposition described by the same writer in 2 Corinthians 4:2 as "handling the word of God deceitfully," which suggests corrupting it with error. What an awesome responsibility it is to teach the message of Jehovah God!

The bible is filled with warnings about the proper approach to the sacred scriptures. For instance, Paul wrote of those who would "pervert [i.e., turn into that of opposite character] the gospel of Christ"(Gal. 1:7), and Peter spoke of those ignorant and unsteadfast persons who twist the Scriptures unto their own destruction (2 Peter 3:16).

The word of God has been settled in heaven (psa. 119:89) and it is not, therefore, to be supplemented, diminished, not altered in any way [c.f. Deut. 4:2; 12:32; Prov. 30:6; Rev. 22:18,19).

It is possible for one to have a large portion of the Scriptures in his mind, and yet have it so confused that he misrepresents the true message of God. The Jews were constantly searching the Old Testament writings (c.f. John 5:39), yet most of them didn't recognize or accept the Messiah. Paul later comments that a veil of prejudice shrouded their hearts when the Law was read (2 Cor. 3:14,15).

How very cautious, therefore, ought we to be in our approach to and presentation of the Holy Bible.
