The Seed

In the Bible illustration of sowing and reaping being used to illustrate the seed as the word of God, and the soil as the human heart (mind), the plant which results from that particular seed falling into good soil (a "good and honest heart") is called the child of God (a member of God's family, the church, 1 Tim 3:14-15).

When Mormon "seed" (doctrine) is planted in a soil (human mind) which allows it to germinate and grow into a plant (that is, when human mind accepts and obeys Mormon doctrine), then the result is a member of the Mormon religion – not a member of the church which Jesus built. When Episcopalian doctrine is planted in a human mind which believes and obeys that doctrine, the result is a member of the Episcopal church. One could go on with every denomination on earth. (The church which Jesus built in not a denomination). Obeying denominational doctrine simply does not result in one's becoming a member of the church Jesus built.

But, every person can rejoice to know that whenever God's seed (that is, His word – the gospel of Jesus Christ, Romans 1:16-17; Luke 8:11) is planted in a human mind which believes and obeys it, the result is always the same: a child of God (Gal. 3: 26-27), a member of the one body, the church (1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 1:22-23; Colossians 1:18). The seed of God brings forth children of God.
