Sermon Outline:

Encountering Jesus: Peace

- I. Encountering Jesus brings peace with God.
  - A. Peace is not first about your mood, it is about your standing.
    - a. Romans 5:1
    - b. Jesus does not talk about peace; He makes peace possible.
  - B. Jesus offers peace as reconciliation.
    - a. John 14:27
    - b. If someone is restless before God, always anxious, always defensive, always unsure; No amount of external calm will fix that.

- II. Encountering Jesus brings peace in the middle of the storm.
  - A. The disciples are doing what Jesus told them to do, cross the lake.
    - a. Luke 8:22-25

- b. Jesus rebukes the wind and the water, there is calm.
- B. Jesus does not promise a life without tribulation.
  - a. John 16:33
  - b. He promises a life where tribulation is not ultimate.

- III. Encountering Jesus brings peace from shame, fear, and a wounded past.
  - A. The woman has been suffering for twelve years.
    - a. Mark 5:25-34
    - b. She is physically drained, financially ruined, socially isolated, and ceremonially unclean.
  - B. Christ speaks some wonderful words:
    - a. *Daughter your faith has made you well; go in peace and be healed of your affliction.*
    - b. This is not a generic farewell.

- IV. Encountering the risen Jesus brings peace that sends us forward.
  - A. The disciples are huddled up in fear and confusion.
    - a. Luke 24:36-39
    - b. Jesus appears and says, *peace be with you.*
  - B. This is crucial:
    - a. Jesus' peace is not sedation; it is preparation.
    - b. He gives peace and then sends them to proclaim repentance and forgiveness of sins in his name.

- V. How do we live in this peace?
  - A. Peace is not only something you feel.
    - a. Philippians 4:6-9
    - b. It brings:
