The Great Invitation of Jesus

I. The invitation is Personal: Come to me.

A. Jesus is the source of rest.

a. Matthew 11:28

b. The rest we need is not found in:

i. Money

ii. Entertainment

iii. Success

iv. Relationships

v. Worldly distractions

B. This invitation reveals his authority.

C. The Invitation is still open.

II. The invitation is wide: All who are weary and heavy laden.

A. Who are the weary?

a. This includes people burdened by:

i. Sin and guilt

ii. Failure and shame

iii. Religious confusion

- iv. Fear of Judgement
- v. The emptiness of worldly living
- B. Sin is a heavy burden.
- C. Jesus' invitation is for all kinds of people.

- III. I will give you rest.
 - A. What kind of rest is this?
 - a. This is not physical rest.
 - b. Christians will still face trials, sorrow, persecution, and hardship.
 - B. Rest is found in salvation, not in self.
 - C. Rest now and rest eternally.

- IV. Take my yoke upon you.
 - A. What is a yoke?
 - a. Matthew 11:29
 - b. A yoke was a wooden beam placed on animals for work and direction.

- B. Jesus is not inviting us to a casual association.
- C. His yoke brings freedom, not bondage.

- V. Learn from me.
 - A. Christianity is a life of learning Christ.
 - a. To come to Jesus means we keep learning:
 - i. His word
 - ii. His will
 - iii. His character
 - iv. His priorities
 - b. This is why regular bible study, worship, prayer, and fellowship matter.
 - B. Learn not only his teaching, but his heart.

- VI. My yoke is easy and my burden is light.
 - A. Easy does not mean no cost.
 - a. Following Jesus has a cost:
 - i. Self-denial
