Spiritual Laziness

Physical laziness can cost a man his job, his health, and his opportunities. Spiritual laziness is even more dangerous because it affects the soul. The Bible repeatedly warns against becoming sluggish in our service to God. Paul wrote, "not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord" (Romans 12:11, LSB). A lazy spirit does not usually appear all at once. It often begins with neglected prayer, careless Bible study, weak worship habits, and a heart that slowly loses its zeal for the Lord.

Spiritual laziness is dangerous because it leaves a Christian vulnerable. When we grow careless, temptation becomes stronger and conviction becomes weaker. The Hebrew writer urged Christians not to become "sluggish," but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises (Hebrews 6:12, LSB). God has never called His people to spiritual idleness. He calls us to grow, to watch, to endure, and to abound in His work.

The cure for spiritual laziness is not mere activity, but renewed devotion. We must stir ourselves up with the Word of God, remember the sacrifice of Christ, and set our minds on eternal things. "Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:58, LSB). A faithful Christian cannot afford to drift through the spiritual life half-awake. Let us serve the Lord with energy, gratitude, and urgency while we still have time.
