Personal Evangelism

Personal evangelism is not just for preachers, elders, or Bible class teachers. It is the responsibility and privilege of every Christian. Jesus told His disciples, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations" (Matthew 28:19). While not everyone will stand before a crowd, every child of God can speak to one person about the gospel.

Personal evangelism often begins with simple things: living a faithful life, showing kindness, speaking of Christ naturally, and inviting others to hear the truth. Andrew brought Peter to Jesus (John 1:40-42). The Samaritan woman told her neighbors about Christ (John 4:28-30). In both cases, ordinary people pointed others to the Savior.

Many Christians hesitate because of fear. We may feel unprepared, afraid of rejection, or unsure what to say. Yet the power is not in our eloquence, but in the gospel itself, "for it is the power of God for salvation" (Romans 1:16). Our task is to plant and water; God gives the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6).

Let us pray for open doors, courage, and wisdom. Let us look for opportunities in our homes, workplaces, schools, and communities. Someone we know needs the truth. Personal evangelism is simply one Christian caring enough to tell another soul about Jesus.
