Christian Growth

The Christian life is not meant to stand still. When a person obeys the gospel, he is born again and begins a new life in Christ. Peter wrote, "like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation" (1 Peter 2:2, LSB). Just as a child must grow physically, a Christian must grow spiritually.

Christian growth begins with the word of God. We cannot become stronger in faith while neglecting the Scriptures. God's word teaches us, corrects us, and equips us "for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17). A growing Christian is one who hungers for truth and allows that truth to shape his thoughts, words, and actions.

Christian growth also requires diligence. Peter said to "be all the more diligent" and to add to our faith moral excellence, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love (2 Peter 1:5-7, LSB). Growth does not happen by accident. It requires prayer, study, obedience, worship, service, and a willingness to change. We must also remember that growth is measured by becoming more like Christ. Paul wrote that we are to "grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, that is Christ" (Ephesians 4:15, LSB). The goal is not merely to know more, but to live more faithfully, love more sincerely, serve more humbly, and stand more firmly.

Every Christian should ask, "Am I growing?" If we are closer to God, stronger in faith, more obedient to His word, and more useful in His kingdom, then we are growing as we should. Let us not be content with spiritual immaturity but press on toward greater faithfulness in Christ.
