Walking in the Light

John writes, "God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all" (1 John 1:5). Since God is light, His people must not live in darkness. To walk in the light means to live openly before God, guided by His word, and separated from the darkness of sin.

Walking in the light does not mean we never stumble. John says, "If we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:7). The Christian life is not a life of sinless perfection, but a life of faithful direction. We keep walking toward God, confessing our sins, repenting when we fall, and trusting the cleansing power of Christ's blood.

According to the gospel, we come into Christ through obedient faith—believing in Him, repenting of sin, confessing His name, and being baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; Galatians 3:27). But after becoming a Christian, we must continue to walk faithfully. Darkness cannot be our home anymore. Let us examine our steps. Are we walking in truth, purity, love, and obedience? Or are we hiding in the darkness of sin? The call of God is clear: leave the darkness and walk in the light.
