### **Keeping the Fire Going**

The Christian life is not meant to be cold, careless, or half-hearted. God wants His people to be zealous for Him. Paul wrote, "Never lagging behind in diligence, being fervent in spirit, serving the Lord" (Romans 12:11). The word "fervent" carries the idea of boiling over. Our faith should be alive, active, and burning with devotion to God.

But every Christian knows that spiritual fire must be maintained. A fire left alone will eventually die down. In the same way, our zeal can weaken if we neglect prayer, Bible study, worship, service, and fellowship with faithful Christians. The world constantly tries to cool our commitment, distract our minds, and pull our hearts away from Christ.

So how do we keep the fire going?

First, stay close to the Word of God. Jeremiah said God's word was "like a burning fire shut up in my bones" (Jeremiah 20:9). Scripture strengthens our faith, corrects our path, and reminds us of our purpose. Second, remain faithful in worship. The early church "continually devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer" (Acts 2:42). Faithful worship keeps our hearts centered on God.

Third, keep serving. Zeal grows when we are busy in the work of the Lord. Paul said to be "always abounding in the work of the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:58). The fire will not keep itself going. We must feed it daily with faith, obedience, prayer, and service. Let us not become lukewarm. Let us burn brightly for Christ until the day He comes.
